Ultimately, then, Lent is a time of doing. After truly listening, we must respond and put into practice what we have learned. In this way, we will bring about the inner conversion to God that is the most fitting preparation for Easter.

3. Give a hearty "Thank you" or compliment to someone you take for granted;
